Module 3: Learning About and Engaging Families of Multilingual Learners (1 hour)

Examines ways to learn about and engage families of young multilingual learners.

Module 4: Strategies for Supporting Multilingual Development in Early Learning and Care Settings (2 hours)

Describes guiding principles for supporting multilingual learners in early learning and care settings. Uses video clips, photos, and illustrations to demonstrate research-based strategies for supporting multilingual learners and continue the development of their home languages as they learn English.
